If a student passes more than one AP exam in Physics, the CSU will apply only six units of credit to the baccalaureate degree, and only 4 units of credit may be applied for certification of CSU GE.

Students who use AP Environmental Science, Physics C: Mechanics or Physics C: Electricity/Magnetism will receive 3 units toward IGETC Area 5A. Therefore, student will need to complete Area 5B and a total of 7 semester/9 quarter units to satisfy Area 5.

****CSU Advanced Placement Policies**

The Advanced Placement examinations listed above may be incorporated into certification of completion of CSU General Education-breadth requirements by Santiago Canyon College. Students must have scored 3, 4, or 5 on an Advanced Placement examination to receive the credit indicated. **All CSU campuses will accept the minimum units toward fulfillment of the designated General Education-Breadth area if the examination is included in full or subject area certification;** individual CSU campuses may choose to accept more units than those specified towards completion of general education breadth requirements. The CSU Minimum Semester Admission unit column reflects what each campus system wide will minimally accept toward admissions units for AP credit. Some CSU campuses may award more than the minimum units listed in this column. That information can be found in each CSU catalog. The CSU campus to which the student is transferring determines the total number of units awarded for successful completion of an Advanced Placement examination and the applicability of the examination to other graduation requirements, such as major.

*****UC Advanced Placement Policies**

IGETC Area credit may be earned for scores of 3, 4 or 5 on Advanced Placement (AP) exams. Each AP exam may be applied to one IGETC area, as satisfying one course requirement, with the exception of LOTE. Students earning a minimum score of 3 in the physical and biological science AP examinations earn credit toward IGETC Area 5 and will meet the laboratory requirement.

AP exams in Chemistry, Biology and Physics B will be granted 4 units for certification. AP exams in Environmental Science, Physics C: Mechanics and Physics C: Electricity/Magnetism will earn 3 semester units for certification; however the laboratory requirement is included. Students who complete these exams will be required to complete an additional 4 semester units to satisfy the minimum required units for Area 5.

The final column reflects what the University of California will award system wide per AP exam for admission to any UC campus. When students are using an AP exam for a requirement other than general education, such as major preparation, they are strongly advised to check with an SCC counselor and/or the Admissions Office of the UC transfer campus to determine how the AP exam will be used to meet campus major and graduation requirements.
