

## **2007 Santiago Canyon College** **Men's Golf Updates**

**May 7, 2007**

### **SANTIAGO CANYON MEN'S GOLF FINISHES SEVENTH AT SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA REGIONALS**

The Santiago Canyon College (SCC) men's golf team finished with a total team score of 774 (395-379) to finish in seventh place at the Southern California Community College Championships held at the par-72 SCGA Golf Course in Murrieta, CA.

College of the Canyons took home first place honors with a team score of 738 (368-370), followed by Palomar College at 746 (379-367) and College of the Desert at 747 (379-368). Individually, Ben Carter (Ventura), Casey Piper (Canyons), Cean Geronimo (Long Beach) and Tyler Schmuckle (Palomar) each finished with a two-round total of 145 to take home first place honors.

SCC sophomore standout Steve Gibson (Villa Park HS) finished in a tie for 15<sup>th</sup> place as he shot a two-round total of 149 (73-76). Other scores for the Hawks included freshman Josh Perez (Villa Park HS) in a tie for 19<sup>th</sup> place with a 150 (79-71), freshman Jordan Andrews (Foothill HS) in a tie for 45<sup>th</sup> place with a 156 (80-76), freshman Austin Glenn (El Dorado HS) in 56<sup>th</sup> place with a 159 (81-78), sophomore Kyle Ortiz (El Modena HS) in a tie for 57<sup>th</sup> place with a 160 (82-78) and sophomore Eric Brambila (El Dorado HS) in 64<sup>th</sup> place with a 163 (84-79).

### **SANTIAGO CANYON MEN'S GOLF FINISHES THIRD AT CONFERENCE FINALS**

The Santiago Canyon College (SCC) men's golf team finished with a total team score of 740 to finish in third place at the Orange Empire Conference (OEC) Finals Monday afternoon in 36-holes of action at the Los Serranos Golf Club in Chino Hills.

SCC freshman Josh Perez (Villa Park HS) took home medalist honors as he finished with a 7-under-par 139 (69-70). Sophomore Steve Gibson (Villa Park HS) finished with the third lowest score on the afternoon as he shot a 5-under-par 141 (69-72). Gibson was also named the OEC Player of the Year as he finished the season with a conference low 70.2 average.

Other scores for SCC included freshman Jordan Andrews (Foothill HS) with a 150 (72-78), sophomore Kyle Ortiz (El Modena HS) with a 155 (80-75), sophomore Eric Brambila (El Dorado HS) with a 157 (77-80) and freshman Austin Glenn (El Dorado HS) with a 159 (81-78).

The Hawks finished in third place in the OEC with a 13-7 record. Saddleback College shot a total team score of 717 to capture the school's ninth consecutive conference title with a 19-1 record. Cypress College (740) finished second in the OEC at 15-5.

SCC, Saddleback, Cypress and Cuyamaca will move on to compete in the Southern California Regional Championships on Monday, May 7 at the SCGA Golf Course in Murrieta, CA. The top four teams and top six individuals will advance to play in the state championship on May 14, in Merced, CA.

## **GIBSON FINISHES WITH 9-BIRDIES AS SANTIAGO CANYON MEN'S GOLF DROPS HEARTBREAKER TO PALOMAR**

The Santiago Canyon College (SCC) men's golf team has lost some tight matches this season, but none closer than Wednesday's heartbreaker against Palomar College at the par-72 Twin Oaks Golf Course in San Marcos.

After adding up the scorecards from each team's top five players the score was tied at 377-377, sending the match into a tie-breaker. The tie-breaker is determined by the score of the sixth golfer from each squad. After the sixth player from each team finished with an 81, the match was sent into a second tie-breaker. In this case, the scores from the top five players from each team on the back nine are used to break the tie. Palomar shot a 189 on the back nine compared to 191 for SCC, breaking the tie and giving the Comets the card-off victory.

Despite windy conditions, sophomore Steve Gibson (Villa Park HS) finished with a school-record nine birdies on his way to shooting a 4-under-par round of 68 to lead the Hawks. Other scores for SCC included sophomore Eric Brambila (El Dorado HS) with a solid even-par round of 72, freshmen Josh Perez (Villa Park HS) and Austin Glenn (El Dorado HS) each with a 78, while sophomore Kyle Ortiz (El Modena HS) and freshman Jordan Andrews (Foothill HS) each carded an 81.

The Hawks, who currently stand at 10-5 in conference play, have lost four of five matches this season by two shots or less. SCC will next compete in the OEC Finals on Monday, Apr. 30 at the Los Serranos Golf Club in Chino Hills.

The Santiago Canyon College (SCC) men's golf team shot a 20-under-par team round of 196 to finish in second place out of 19 teams at the Victor Valley College 'Pnoomonia' Invitational Four-Ball Tournament at the par-72 Spring Valley Lake Country Club.

The SCC freshman duo of Josh Perez (Villa Park HS) and Jordan Andrews (Foothills HS) took home individual honors with a 10-under-par round of 62. Andrews finished with five birdies on the front nine and Perez birdied the last five holes on the back nine to lead the Hawks.
