- You must attach copies of your official transcripts (unless they are already on file with the SCC Admissions and Records Office).
  - Entering freshmen submit high school transcripts.
  - Continuing college students submit transcripts from all colleges attended.
- Your high school or previous college(s) will not forward transcripts. You must request official copies to be sent to SCC.

*When and where to submit your application*

- Applications for the fall semester are due October 8, with notification occurring by November 9.
- Applications for the spring semester are due March 4, with notification occurring by April 1.
- Submit your completed application with all required records attached to the SCC Admissions & Records Office, E-101.
