## HOW TO APPLY AND REGISTER

### NOTE:

If you did not attend Santiago Canyon College or Santa Ana College during the spring 2010 semester, you must reapply to the college. Go to [www.sccollege.edu](http://www.sccollege.edu) and click on APPLY. Read all the information prior to beginning to complete the application. After submitting your application, you will receive an e-mail confirmation from CCCApply. Within 5 days you will receive an e-mail from Santiago Canyon College with your Student ID number, login number and registration information. You will be able to log into Online Records to view your registration date.

### STEP ONE:

To apply to Santiago Canyon College, complete an application online at [www.sccollege.edu](http://www.sccollege.edu). Click on the **APPLY NOW** link. After submitting all of your information, you will receive an e-mail confirmation from CCCApply. Within 2-3 days, you will receive another e-mail from Santiago Canyon College with your student ID number and important registration information. You will be able to log onto Online Records to view your registration date within 2-3 business days of your application.

### STEP TWO:

- 3 Log in (if you forgot your User ID or Password, return to the main menu and click on "What's My User ID" or "What's my Password" link)
- 4 Click on "Students" from the Main Menu
- 5 Click on "Register for Sections" from the Registration Menu.
- 6 Follow the instructions to complete your registration.
- 7 If you have placed yourself on a wait list, check your schedule daily.
- 8 To avoid being dropped for non-payment, pay fees immediately under "Pay on My Account."

#### DROP FOR NON-PAYMENT POLICY: NEW POLICY

Enrollment fees must be paid IN FULL within three days of registration or all of your classes will be dropped and released to other students. The day you register is your first day. If you need assistance paying your enrollment fees and would like to apply for a Fee Waiver, go to [www.cccapply.org/BOG](http://www.cccapply.org/BOG) Waiver/. It is your responsibility to check your account balance and pay the amount owed. As a general rule, Summer 2010 refunds would only be given if students drop on or before the first class meeting.

### STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY TO DROP CLASSES

To avoid a "W" grade, students must drop classes on or before the day of the first class meeting. Students will not be automatically dropped for non-attendance. You must drop online. After the first day of the first class meeting you will not be eligible to receive a refund for your classes nor will you be exempt from enrollment fees.

### WAIT LIST POLICY

You are not able to wait list more than one section of the same course. You cannot Wait List a course that will conflict with another course. As seats become available, students will be moved into an open seat. **It is your responsibility to periodically check your class schedule online, or you may lose your place on the Wait List.** You will be notified by email (it is your responsibility to make sure that your e-mail is up-to-date) and **will have 3 days to pay for the course or you will be dropped.** If your name remains on the Wait List, you must attend the first class meeting and obtain the instructor's signature to add the course (Log in to Online Records often to check your status on the wait list). Submit your Add Card to the Admissions Office and pay immediately.

**Instructor signature is required for all petitioned adds.**

### PAY FEES IMMEDIATELY

Fees must be paid within 3 days of registering for courses or you will be dropped for non-payment. The date that you register counts as the first day. As a general rule, Summer 2010 refunds would only be given if students drop on or before the first class meeting.

**Refunds:** Students will be eligible for a refund if they drop their course on or before the day of the first class meeting.

**Do not send cash!** Make checks payable to "RSCCD" and write your Student ID number on the check.

**Enrollment Fee:** \$26.00 per unit, with no maximum. Payment is required of all students upon registering for classes.

**Non-Resident Tuition:** \$200.00 per unit for out-of-state residents and for students who are a citizens of a foreign country. These fees are in addition to the per unit enrollment fee of \$26.00. Questions regarding residency determination may be referred to the Admissions office.

**Health Fee:** \$14.00 for Summer session. This fee is mandatory for SCC and SAC campus classes.

**Material Fee:** Material fee may be required for a course. Check classes online for specific fees.

**Student Service Fee:** \$3.00 is payable for classes at SCC and SAC campuses. The fee includes: 1) \$1.50 for College Services: library, student and instructional services; and 2) \$1.50 for college activities. **SCC also charges a \$1.00 Student Representation Fee.** Photo ID and session validation is available at the Cashier's Office, E -102. The student services fee is optional.

**Parking Fee:** \$10.00. A permit is required to park on campus and may be purchased at registration. Motorcycles are exempt in designated parking areas.

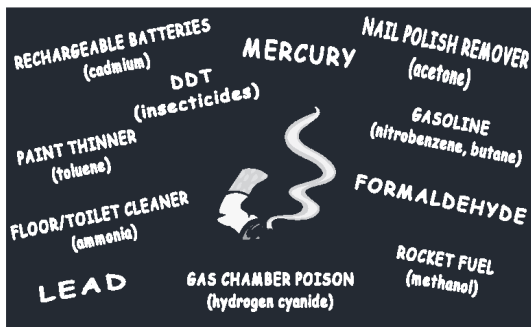

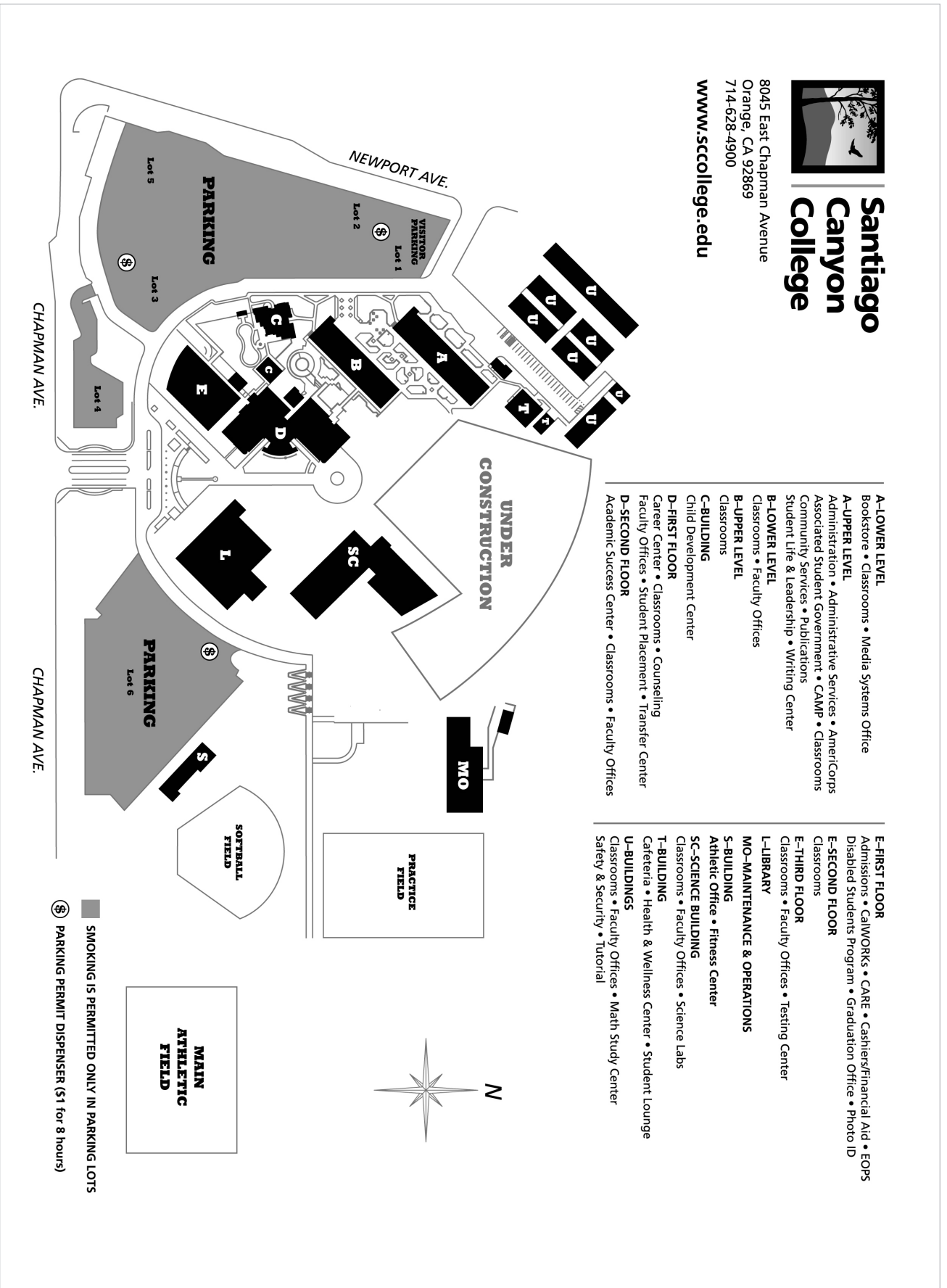
