ORANGE ROTARY HIGH SCHOOL TO THE FUTURE SCHOLARSHIP ** **DUE APRIL 17, 2009**

CRITERIA:

Please Note: This scholarship is limited to students graduating from Canyon, El Modena, Orange, Richland and Villa Park High Schools **ONLY**. No other applicants will be considered.

GPA: 3.0

Leadership Skills: Participation in high school activities and clubs.

Community Involvement: Documented volunteer work in service to others.

Employment: Work outside school as well as any jobs held on campus. (optional)

Number & Amount of Award: One award given for 2-year college program, not to exceed \$1,100/yearly.

Total Award: \$2,200 over two years.

** You may turn in one application package on April 17, 2009 for all scholarships **OR** turn in two application packages on both due dates (April 17, 2009 and May 28, 2009)- one for Orange Rotary and one for any other scholarship for which you are applying.

SCC LEADERSHIP & ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP **HORACE SCOTT LEADERSHIP & ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP**

CRITERIA:

GPA: 3.0 and at least one of the following:

Leadership Skills: Participation in high school activities and clubs.

Community Involvement: Volunteer public or private.

CHANCELLOR'S BALL EARLY DECISION SCHOLARSHIP

CRITERIA:

GPA: 2.5

Enrollment: Registered as an AB 540 Student with at least 6 units for Fall 2009 and participated in the Early Decision Registration Process.

Requirements: Recipient will attend two academic success workshops, meet with a High School and Community Outreach Specialist, and meet with a counselor four times per year.

Number & Amount of Award: Five \$500 awards.

1. Complete the attached application form, all attachments and biographical statement and return to:

As noted, you may turn in an application package for Orange Rotary and turn in a separate application for the other scholarships OR you may turn in one application package for all scholarships by the April 17th deadline.

2. The following items **MUST** be attached to your application:

- a. An unofficial high school transcript which includes the Fall 2008 semester of your senior year and your Spring 2009 work in progress;
- b. One to three letters of recommendation from people who know first-hand of your achievements and your qualifications for the scholarship;
- c. Your Personal Statement

3. Completed applications are due May 28, 2009 (April 17, 2009 for the Orange Rotary Scholarship) to the Scholarship Office (A-206-A) located at:

4. Applications are **NOT** considered complete unless necessary items are attached and the application is **SIGNED**. **Incomplete applications will NOT be considered.**
