### **I N T R O D U C T I O N :**

Santiago Canyon College (SCC) scholarships are awarded on the basis of criteria established by donors. Please refer to the specific description for each scholarship. Scholarships are available to SCC graduating sophomores, SCC students transferring as a junior to a four-year college or university, and students who are continuing their education in academic programs at SCC. Scholarship assistance is provided by individual donors, national associations, local clubs, societies and businesses. All awards are based on the receipt of funding from donors. Scholarship recipients are selected by the Scholarship Selection Committee unless indicated as a donor select scholarship in which case the recipients are selected by a specific donor.

**NOTICE REGARDING SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS OVER \$799:** Depending on a scholarship recipient's financial aid eligibility, you may receive the scholarship award over two terms (Fall & Spring). The scholarship office will determine the disbursements frequency.

We will attempt to notify all scholarship award recipients by mail, using the address on your college application. **If you have had a change of address, since registering, please notify the scholarship office.**

### **R E Q U I R E M E N T S :**

Applicants **MUST** be: **Registered for classes at Santiago Canyon College—SCC must be declared as your 'Home Campus' AND Enrolled at SCC in a minimum of six (6) units** for the Fall 2010 and the Spring 2011 semesters, **AND Have a total of 12 college units by the completion of the Spring 2011 semester.** For purposes of this application process, all academic information **MUST** show on your SCC transcript by the deadline date of **April 2, 2010.**

In addition to the Scholarship Program requirements, each scholarship has its own criteria, read carefully through this book to determine if your qualifications match the criteria listed. **You may apply for any and all scholarships for which you meet the criteria.** If you have any questions, check with the SCC Scholarship Program Office. (A-206-A).

**List all scholarships** you are applying for on the **Application Cover Page (Page 19).** **Fill out the ENTIRE application.** An application form is included at the back of this booklet for your convenience. You may make copies of this form. **Submit an original, SIGNED application and one copy** to the SCC Scholarship Office **ON OR BEFORE the April 2, 2010** deadline date. **Be sure to include ALL required attachments.** An incomplete application packet may not be eligible for consideration. **REMEMBER:** It is YOUR responsibility to have all items to the SCC Scholarship Office on or before the **April 2, 2010** deadline.

### **R E C O M M E N D A T I O N L E T T E R S :**

For most scholarships one (1) letter of recommendation is all that needs to be included in your application packet—**BUT** be sure to check the *specific* requirements of each scholarship you apply for. Some scholarships may require more than one, some require letters of recommendation from specific sources. Recommendation letters may come from an instructor, school advisor, community leader, or an employer. **PLEASE NOTE:** Students **MUST** include a minimum of one—TO A MAXIMUM OF THREE—letters of recommendation in the application packet. **DO NOT INCLUDE MORE THAN THREE.** There is a **Personal Recommendation Form** in this packet (p.23), to be used *in place* of the traditional letter of recommendation, you do not need both. Should you leave this form with an instructor, it is your responsibility to make sure that this form is sent to the Scholarship Office (A-206-A) on or before the **April 2, 2010** deadline.

## **AUTOBIOGRAPHICAL STATEMENT/PERSONAL STATEMENT:**

This is your opportunity to tell the Scholarship Selection Committee all about yourself. Discuss your future plans, why you need this scholarship, etc. In your statement be sure to touch on all of the scholarship qualifying criteria for every scholarship that you are applying. Your packet must speak for you and answer any and all personal questions the committee may have about you. **Please limit this statement to ONE page.** It may be single-spaced. For more information about preparing this statement, or any other questions you may have, we suggest you attend a Scholarship Workshop. If you have questions, please contact the Scholarship Office.

## **I M P O R T A N T :**

**BE SURE TO SIGN YOUR APPLICATION PACKAGE.** The Scholarship Office is unable to obtain your transcripts or share application information if your application package is unsigned. **KEEP THIS BOOK.** The overall guidelines and rules of competition are listed here for your reference. You may need to refer to them after the **April 2, 2010** deadline.

## **SCHOLARSHIP WORKSHOPS:**

The SCC Scholarship Program will offer two workshops that will provide information on how to apply for scholarships offered at Santiago Canyon College. The workshops cover information on presentation, writing a personal statement, recommendation letter and will answer questions designed to make each student the best applicant. The dates for the workshops are: Wednesday, March 10, 2010 and Tuesday, March 16, 2010. Please sign up in the Scholarship Office, A-206-A. For students unable to attend a workshop, appointments are available for personal assistance.

Student organizations or faculty members wishing to arrange for a presentation may contact the Scholarship Program Office at (714) 628-4793 to arrange for a 15 minute presentation.

## **D E A D L I N E :**

Return completed application packets to the SCC Scholarship Program Office at Santiago Canyon College (A-206-A) by noon on **April 2, 2010.** (To guarantee a complete application packet, use the check list provided on page 17.) Exceptions can be granted on a case by case basis. The office is located on the second floor of the A Building, Room A-206-A. Applications may be mailed to the following address:

## **GRACE ALBERTS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

**GPA:** 2.5  
**INCOME:** Financial information (1040) required  
**STATUS:** Continuing full-time student at SCC in Fall '10  
**AWARD(S):** One  
**AMOUNT:** \$1,000  
**Requirements:** All majors; Asian student who is U.S. citizen and Orange County resident; full-time enrollment (minimum of 12 units) each semester of award.

### **GRACE ALBERTS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

**The Name of the Scholarship** may refer to the donor, the category, etc. This particular scholarship was established as a memorial tribute to Grace Alberts.

**GPA: 2.5**

**GPA: (Grade Point Average)** This is the grade point average you must have in order to apply. This scholarship requires that your GPA be 2.5.

**INCOME: Financial information (1040) required**

**Income:** This informs you whether or not you are required to provide proof of financial need (the 1040 Federal Income Tax form.) For this scholarship your financial information IS required.

**Awards:** Indicates the number of recipients to be awarded from this scholarship. For this scholarship there is only one.

**AMOUNT: \$1,000**

**Amount:** Refers to the amount each award will be. The amount of this scholarship is \$1,000. This award will be given in two equal amounts, \$500 in the Fall and \$500 in the Spring.

**Requirements: All majors; Asian student who is U.S. citizen and Orange County resident; full-time enrollment (minimum of 12 units) each semester of award.**

**Requirements:** This section refers to the criteria you must satisfy in order to qualify for this scholarship. ## Fund a Scholarship Legacy

The scholarship program offers an easy and convenient way for individual, service club or business donors to assist students who are committed to succeed and who are building their future at **Santiago Canyon College**. ### Giving Opportunities:

**BUY THE BOOK SOCIETY**- It is estimated that for every class enrolled a student can expect to pay \$100-\$200 for textbooks. Therefore, a student enrolled in four classes can estimate that their textbook costs alone could exceed \$500. For a donation of \$500, an individual, company, or group can become a member of the BUY THE BOOK SOCIETY. Funds donated will be directed to a textbook endowment fund at SCC. These revenues will be used exclusively as an alternate source of funds for students who cannot afford all or a portion of their textbook costs.

**A GIFT** of \$750-\$1,000 covers the average cost of fees and books for a full-time student at Santiago Canyon College for one semester.

**ENDOWED** scholarships live on in perpetuity. A minimum gift of \$10,000 will establish an endowed fund. Only the interest earned is awarded each year.

**ANNUAL** scholarships, of less than \$5,000, are awarded each year and are renewable on an annual basis.
