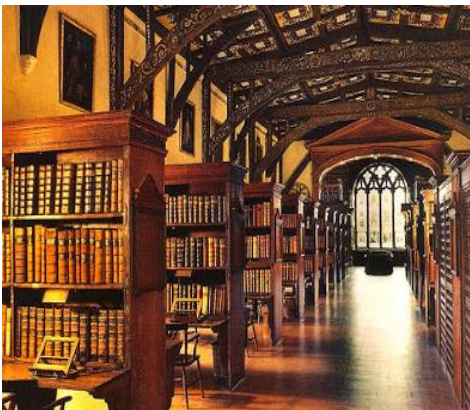

I am online, virtual, remote ... you name it. I am here for you.

Q: Keeping Current for you and your students?

1. Student Research Help

The physical library building may be currently closed, but online assistance by way of Ask A Librarian chat, Ask A Librarian email and text, and appointment using Zoom are available Monday-Thursday from 7:30am-8:00pm and Friday from 7:30am-12:30pm. We can assist students locating online textbooks, eBooks, full-text online articles, using the citation software NoodleTools, and more.

2. Course Reserves

During the COVID-19 Pandemic, the Library's Course Reserve service has been disrupted. Students may be able to temporarily access some textbooks online through VitalSource and RedShelf. Students can contact a librarian for assistance in locating online textbooks. If we cannot locate the material, we will ask the student to contact you. We recommend that you contact your publisher representative or the campus bookstore to see if temporary online access can be obtained.

3. Finding Articles Online Workshop – Available NOW!
