The Student Leadership Institute (SLI) at Santiago Canyon College is a non-credit certificate program in partnership with Cal State Fullerton. SLI Students are required to attend a series of workshops and will earn a leadership certificate from Cal State Fullerton upon program completion. Participation in SLI is free of charge and open to all SCC students. There are no minimum unit requirements, specific GPA nor prior leadership experience needed to participate in the program.
