




Articulation Timeline Cycles

What is Articulation?



“The process of developing a formal, bilateral, written agreement that identifies a course (or sequence of courses) on a “sending” campus that are comparable to, or acceptable in lieu of, specific course requirements at a “receiving” campus.”

California Intersegmental Articulation Council (CIAC)



SCC courses are articulated for

- Baccalaureate-credit
- General Education Breadth (GE)
- Course-to-course (by department)
- Lower-division major preparation agreements

What is the intent of the course?

- ▶ *Do you want the course to be comparable to a specific lower-division course at a four-year university?*
 - ▶ Four-year course syllabus
 - ▶ Once course is deem CSU and/or UC transferable Leonor submits course at faculty's request for:
 - ▶ Course-to-course articulation
 - ▶ Lower-division major preparation agreement
 - ▶ Use [Legacy ASSIST Maintenance Report System](#) to research course comparability
 - ▶ **User Name:** SANTIAGO
 - ▶ **Password:** S275ANTIAGO
 - ▶ Private institution articulation
 - ▶ Department-to-Department meetings
 - ▶ Upon faculty's request Leonor will submit articulation requests

Timeline for UC Transfer, IGETC, CSU GE-Breadth


Course Outline of Record (COR)	Submittal Month	Notification	Effective Year
ASSIST Inventory	On-going	Immediate	Current Academic Year
Submit COR for UC-TCA	June-September	October	Future Academic Year (Jul'17 for 2017-2018)
Submit COR for CSU-GE Breadth	1 st week of December	April-June	Current Academic Year (Dec'17 for 2017-2018)
Submit COR for IGETC	1 st week of December	April-June	Future Academic Year (Dec'17 for 2017-2018)

For the December 2018 CSU-GE Breadth/IGETC and American Institutions review cycle, course approved for GE or AI will **NO LONGER BE BACKDATED** in any area (Dec'18 for 2019-2020)

Reasons why courses are denied for articulation

- ▶ Course outline is too old (5 years+)
- ▶ Textbooks are too old (7 years)
- ▶ Content missing specific topics
- ▶ Description and objective do not aligned
- ▶ Course is not comparable
- ▶ University is not accepting articulation for a course
- ▶ Variable topic course
- ▶ Content focuses more on applied theory/professional development



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
