Recommendation for the Adoption of Canvas as Santiago Canyon College's Learning Management System

Moved: Professor Taylor

Seconded: Professor Cummins

Whereas, The Online Education Initiative (OEI) is a collaborative effort among California Community Colleges (CCC) to ensure that significantly more students are able to complete their educational goals by increasing both access to and success in high-quality online courses; and

Whereas, The OEI has committed to providing Canvas, a learning management system (LMS) that can offer high-quality online classes, support our traditional on-campus classes, and have a potential cost savings to RSCCD, to the CCC system for free through the 2018 school year and have committed to paying approximately two-thirds of the cost of Canvas going forward; and

Whereas, A LMS task force was created by the Technology Committees of both SAC and SCC to evaluate and determine if Canvas would meet our needs and after the evaluation process, members voted unanimously to recommend that RSCCD adopt Canvas (19-0 in favor of the adoption);

Resolved, That the Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College recommend the adoption of Canvas for our campus learning management system.
