Support for Adoption of the Educational Master Planning Hybrid Program Review Template

Whereas, The Santiago Canyon College (SCC) 2016-2022 Educational Master Plan states that the Program Review document is “the central link between the RSCCD and college goals, accreditation feedback, and the department plans,”

Whereas, According to SCC’s Actionable Improvement Plan 3 published in the 2016 Midterm Report: “Santiago Canyon College will develop a program review process that will evaluate both the instructional and service oriented components of units across the College that serve both functions, such as with Counseling, Library Science and Information Studies, and the Academic Success Center. (I.B.7.);”

Whereas, The SCC Educational Master Planning Committee (EMPC) created an ad hoc committee with representatives from Academic Affairs, Administrative Services and Student Services and said ad hoc committee merged all existing program review templates, consolidated template sections that shared similarities, and maintained template sections that are specific to instructional programs and services areas independently; and

Whereas, The SCC Educational Master Planning Committee has reviewed the hybrid template that was created by the ad hoc committee and recommends that this new template will allow SCC to streamline and equitize program review in the planning process for all areas of the college;

Resolved, That the Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College support the adoption of the 2018-21 Hybrid Program Review Template.
