Designate Remote Blended Instruction as Hybrid

Whereas, the remote blended (RB) instructional format was created to provide instructors the flexibility to combine synchronous and asynchronous instruction when teaching remote courses during the COVID-19 pandemic;

Whereas, The hybrid instructional method was previously defined as a combination of synchronous and asynchronous online instruction into a single course; and

Whereas, The Academic Senate for Santiago Canyon College has previously approved the need to complete the 120-hour online teaching certification (OTC) for any instructor wishing to teach a hybrid course;

Resolved, The Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College designate remote blended (RB) courses as equivalent to hybrid instruction;

Resolved, The Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College endorse that faculty wishing to teach a remote blended (RB) courses must complete the online teaching certification (OTC); and

Resolved, The Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College endorse that faculty in possession of the Remote Instruction Certification (RIC) may teach hybrid courses in Spring 2021 with an approved mentor (a fully certified online instructor).
