Request for Academic Senate President to Re-open Dialogue About the Enrollment Management Committee's Class Cancellation Guiding Principles Recommendation

Moved: CIC Chair Evelt

Whereas, The participatory governance Enrollment Management Committee with membership from all college constituents and the Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College both unanimously affirmed, and the College Council had a majority of its membership affirm the Enrollment Management Committee Fall 2020 Class Cancellation Principles Recommendation document;

Whereas, The Interim College President included the following in his 15 December 2020 written comments to the College Council membership rejecting the College Council recommendation: "In the meantime, I will be sharing the eight guiding principles that are listed with our deans so these principles can immediately be used for the spring intersession and spring semester. For transparency, I will also be asking Martin Stringer, Vice President of Academic Affairs, to disseminate these eight guiding principles to department chairs so that they too can use it as a guide"; and

Whereas, Not all department chairs received the "eight guiding principles" and the "eight guiding principles" document did not go through the governance process when enrollment management clearly falls under AB 1725 #5 "Standard or policies regarding student preparation and success," which is deemed primary advice and judgment of the Academic Senate per the Rancho Santiago Community College District's BP 2410 Board Policies and Administrative Regulations and AB 1725 #4 "Educational program development," which is deemed mutual agreement per the Rancho Santiago Community College District's BP 2410 Board Policies and Administrative Regulations;

Resolved, The Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College request that the Academic Senate President re-open dialogue about the Enrollment Management Committee's, College Council's, and Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College's affirmation of the Enrollment Management Committee Fall 2020 Class Cancellation Principles Recommendation document.
