Adoption of New Instructional Modalities

Moved: Senator Castellanos

Seconded: Senator Gates

Whereas, The shift to remote instruction required colleges to implement synchronous remote instruction to allow students to complete the Spring 2020 semester;

Whereas, Synchronous remote instruction (remote live and remote blended) has continued into Fall 2021 to allow students greater flexibility to complete their educational goals;

Whereas, Remote synchronous instruction has been coded as face-to-face instruction throughout the pandemic, but these courses will need to be coded as online beginning in January 2022; and

Whereas, The Vice Presidents of Academic Affairs have collaborated with the Distance Education Coordinators to develop new schedule language that designates remote courses as online and provides students with information about whether the course will meet synchronously, asynchronously, have on campus meetings, or some combination of these three options;

Resolved, The Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College adopt the new instructional modalities and support their use beginning with the Spring 2022 Intersession.
