Academic Senate Support for Students in Collegial Consultation

Moved: Senator Hauscarriague

Seconded: Senator Gozalez

Whereas, Education Code §70901 requires “governing boards of community college districts to ensure faculty, staff, and students the right to participate effectively in district and college governance, and the opportunity to express their opinions at the campus level and to ensure that these opinions are given every reasonable consideration, and the right of academic senates to assume primary responsibility for making recommendations in the areas of curriculum and academic standards”;

Whereas, Title 5 51023.7 requires “Governing boards adopt policies and procedures that provide students opportunity to participate effectively in district and college governance on formulation and development of policies and procedures and processes for jointly developing recommendations that have or will have a significant effect on students”;

Whereas, Policies and procedures that have a significant impact on students, known as the 9+1, are grading policies, codes of student conduct, academic disciplinary policies, curriculum development, courses or programs which should be initiated or discontinued, processes for institutional planning and budget development, standards and policies regarding student preparation and success, student services planning and development, student fees within the authority of the district to adopt, and any other district and college policy, procedure or related matter that the district governing board determines will have a significant effect on students”; and

Whereas, Santiago Canyon College and RSCCD include student membership in all governance committees in these areas, but rarely provide training to enable the students to effectively represent and advocate for their positions;

Resolved, That the Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College request that all faculty and administrative co-chairs reach out to their student representatives at the beginning of each academic year to provide an orientation on what the committee does, what types of recommendations the committee makes, and how the committee’s recommendations fit into college and district governance; and

Resolved, That the Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College direct the Secretary/Treasurer to contact the Associated Student Government President at the beginning of each academic year to provide them with information about the role of the Academic Senate, collegial governance, and how faculty and students can work together to ensure effective college and district governance.
