Implementation of Collegial Governance Task Force Recommendations

Moved: Senator El Said

Seconded: Senator James

Whereas, The Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College and the SCC College Council created the Collegial Governance Task Force to review the existing collegial governance structure to ensure that recommendations had a clear path to adoption, that all constituencies are able to participate in decision making, and that the governance structure operate as efficiently as possible;

Whereas, The Collegial Governance Task Force met during the 2021-22 academic year and has forwarded their recommendations to the Academic Senate and the College Council for review;

Whereas, Only some collegial governance committees were able to participate in the Task Force and the existing governance committees should review the task force's recommendations and submit their recommended changes to the Academic Senate and College Council for approval; and

Whereas, The Collegial Governance Task Force has not yet defined what is a council, committee, subcommittee, workgroup, advisory, or task force;

Resolved, That the Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College request that the Collegial Governance Task Force meet during Fall 2022 to create definitions of a council, committee, subcommittee, workgroup, advisory, and task force and submit those recommended definitions to the Academic Senate no later than February 2023;

Resolved, That the Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College direct the Academic Senate Vice President to distribute the recommendations of the Collegial Governance Task Force to the co-chairs of all committees for review and discussion; and

Resolved, That the Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College direct all governance committees to submit their recommended revisions to the to the Academic Senate and College Council no later than March 2023.
