Resolved, That the Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College shall henceforth place the name of the current Faculty Excellence Award recipient and all who win afterward into a lottery so that one name may be drawn during the year Santiago Canyon College is to put forth a nominee for Orange County Teacher of the Year Award; if the person drawn upon does not wish to pursue the award, another name will be drawn, and the names of those that decline for that year shall be placed back into the lottery for future years.
