Resolution for Creation of a Faculty Enrollment Management Task Force

Whereas, Title 5 §53200 establishes the academic senate's roles, including responsibility for recommendations about academic and professional matters, curriculum, educational program development, standards and policies regarding student preparation and success as well as processes for planning and budget; and

Whereas, scheduling includes clarifying what students need, and faculty understand why students need a "general education"; and

Whereas, faculty should determine the pedagogically appropriate class size, the course sequencing, and the pre-requisite courses;

Resolved, The Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College create a Faculty Enrollment Management Task Force; and

Resolved, The Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College charge the Faculty Enrollment Management Task Force to compile a faculty enrollment management philosophy, create an Enrollment Management Committee membership draft/concept, and recommend whether or not the faculty should adopt the ASCCC Enrollment Management Revisited paper; and

Resolved, The Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College request that the Faculty Enrollment Management Task Force members complete their tasks and make their recommendations by the 2 April 2013 Academic Senate of Santiago Canyon College meeting.
