Resolution in Support of the District Purchase of Task Stream Assessment Management Software

Whereas, Santiago Canyon College must comply with ACCJC guidelines regarding Student Learning Outcomes and Assessments:

Appropriate resources are being allocated to support student learning outcomes and assessment; Student learning outcomes and authentic assessment are in place for courses, programs, and degrees; Results of assessment are being used for improvement and further alignment of institution-wide practices; There is widespread institutional dialogue about the results; Decision-making includes dialogue on the results of assessment and is purposefully directed toward improving student learning; and Comprehensive assessment reports exist and are completed on a regular basis;

Whereas, a major component of the Title V grant specifies that during the first year (Oct. 1, 2010-Sept. 30, 2011), the college is to purchase software to facilitate collection of student assessment data, (and this decision was delayed into year two as it took longer to make a thoughtful, deliberate decision);

Whereas, the Student Learning Outcomes and Review Committee (SLOARC) supports the purchase, the Software Demonstration Workshop participants ranked Task Stream highest, other colleges who use Task Stream have rated it highly, and the SCC Office of Institutional Effectiveness determined that Task Stream best meets predetermined criteria on which a purchase was to be based;

Resolved, that the Santiago Canyon College Academic Senate supports the purchase of Task Stream software for the District without delay and to be reevaluated at the end of the grant (September 30, 2015).
