### Mission

The mission of the Santiago Canyon College Honors Program Committee (HPC) is to oversee the Honors Program and work with the Honors Program Coordinator(s) to establish the standards, procedures, and policies of the Program.

### Responsibilities

- Assist the Coordinator(s) in recruiting new students and in promoting and publicizing the Honors Program and its activities
- Review and make recommendations for projected offerings as compiled by the Coordinator(s) and Counselor
- Review and make recommendations for the schedule of Honors classes as compiled by the Coordinator(s) and Counselor
- Review and make recommendations for Honors elements of proposed Honors courses before going to curriculum cluster committees and the Curriculum and Instruction Council (CIC)
- Review existing Honors courses ~~during their triennial~~ as aligned with the curriculum review process
- Solicit course development from other disciplines
- ~~Approve or deny~~ Review requests for exception to program rules and regulations
- Select Honors scholarship recipients
- Assist with Honors Program Retreat/Reception
- ~~Assist with selection of Honors Program students to participate in the~~ Encourage and support student participation in the Honors Transfer Council of California (HTCC) Research Conference
- Review student representative applications
- Establish and review standards, procedures, and policies
