

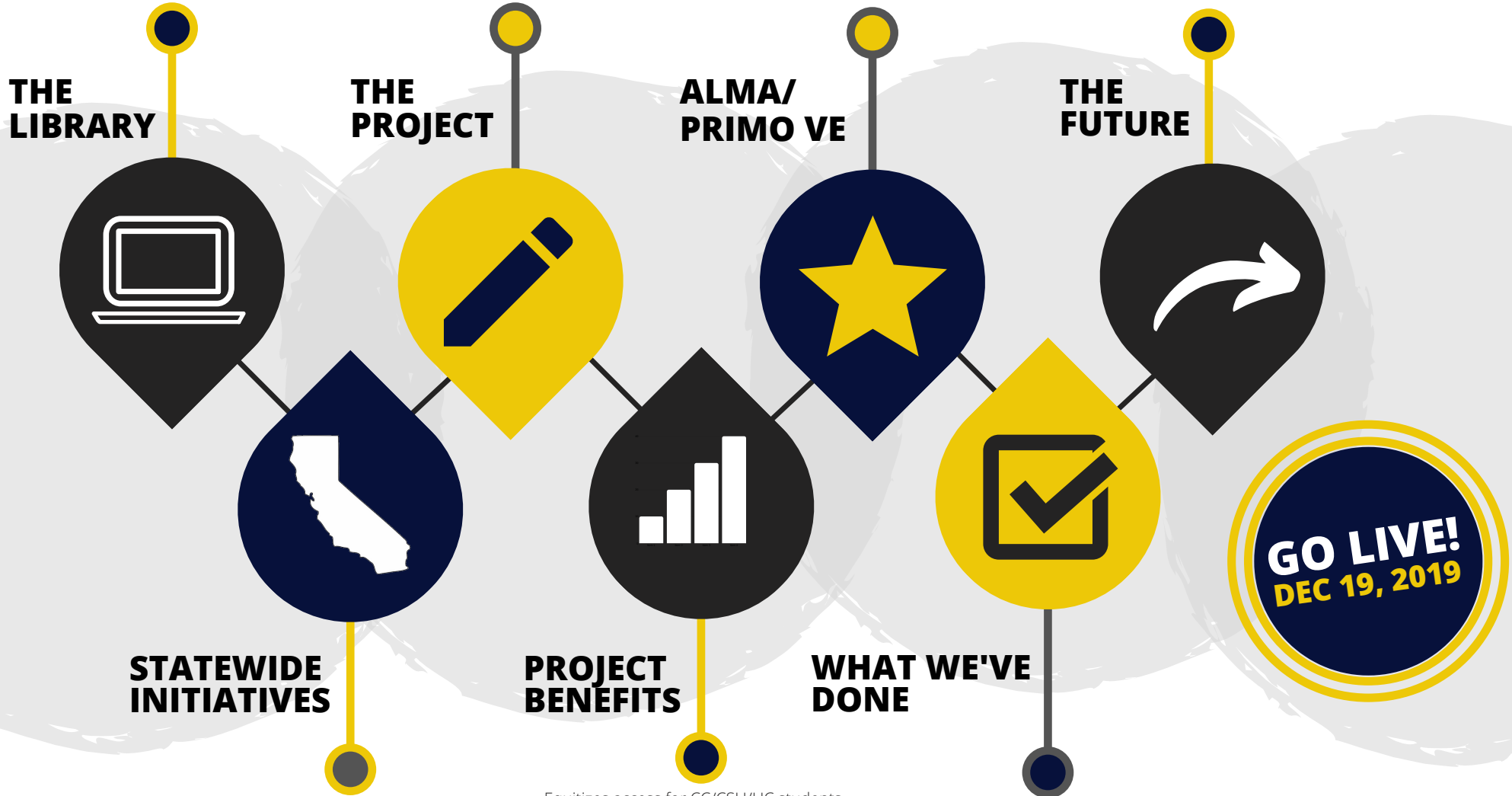
Lorenzo A. Ramirez Library at Santiago Canyon College | The LSP Project Explained

The Library Services Platform (LSP) project is a statewide initiative to implement a unified resource management system across 110 California community college libraries.

Alma/Primo VE is a cloud-based paradigm shifting enterprise system. There is nothing out-of-the-box or turn-key about it. It is highly complex and fully customizable, almost too much so.
