

NEW to NoodleTools?

If you are **NEW** to **NoodleTools** with Santiago Canyon College:

1) You must first create an account through the [link provided on our database page](#). By using our link, you are ensured a FREE account as a Santiago Canyon College student/faculty member.

2) When you click on the link above:

- If you are OFF-CAMPUS, you need to log in with your **WebAdvior ID number and password**.
- Once you are logged in, you will see this page:
