College Assistance Migrant Program

CAMP is a federally funded program designed to assist migrant students successfully complete their first year at Santiago Canyon College (SCC). CAMP supports students through a variety of programs and services available to them, and equips them with the skills and tools to be academically accomplished.

Requirements

To be eligible to participate in CAMP you must:

- Be a migrant or seasonal farm worker*; or a dependent of a migrant or seasonal farm worker
- Be a legal resident
- Be a college freshman or have completed less than 30 college credit units
- Be enrolled at Santiago Canyon College or Santa Ana College

*Migrant Farm worker - a seasonal farm worker whose employment requires travel and whose work entails harvesting or transporting raw products. Seasonal Farm worker - is a person who was employed for a minimum of 75 days in farm work on a temporary or seasonal (not year-round) basis.

Employment related to the production of crops, livestock, dairy products, tree logging, fishing, packaging and/or transportation of raw products, and work performed for wages or personal livelihood on a ranch, farm, or similar businesses are eligible.
