

REFUND & TRANSFER POLICY FOR ALL EVENT S:

Refund and transfer requests must be made (5) business days prior to the EVENT less a \$25 processing Fee per person. Day Tours: may be canceled up to 10 days prior to departure date less a \$25 processing Fee . A refund will only be issued if your space can be resold. You may send a substitute in place. RETURNED CHECKS & REFUNDS BY CHECK, CASH OR MONEY ORDER:





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
